Sunday is the big day. Vehicles will assemble at the Ti Tree Racecourse, with the Grand Parade through the main street of Cooma starting at 10am. The Shannons-sponsored parade will finish at the Showground where the vehicles will be displayed, from the 1948 Series Ones to the biggest and brightest Range Rover HSE's, and every model in between. Again there will be plenty of activities at the Showground, with Land Rover's Terrapod a major feature. We will see the latest model vehicles put through their paces. LROC (Sydney Branch) are organising two technical workshops over the weekend.

There will be loads of prizes over the course of the day and radiator badges awarded to 'best in class' for the Show and Shine.
